FINANCIAL AID

All Saints Episcopal Day School offers a comprehensive financial aid program to all our families who have a demonstrated need. The financial aid program is designed to make the school accessible to all families who value the long-term benefits of an independent school education for their child.

Families interested in applying for financial aid should:

- Check the box on the application indicating an interest in financial aid or request the Parents' Financial Statement (PFS) application from the school.
- Complete the (PFS) application and mail original to the School and Student Service for Financial Aid. Be sure to include a check payable to the School and Student Service (SSS) for the processing fee.
- Submit a copy of the PFS application and all supporting documents to the school by January 2, together with a copy of your most recent Federal and State tax forms, including W-2's and 1099's. Materials must be received by the deadline to ensure a timely determination of award.
- Submit a cover letter to the school, with the above materials, explaining any financial circumstances that may not be covered in the PFS and supporting documents.
